## RAW MEATY BONES

If you keep your teeth clean you won't get fleas - provided you're a cat or dog! This may need a bit of swallowing, but it's well explained by Australian Tom Lonsdale in his revealing book about the health of cats and dogs.

Dr Lonsdale points out that cats and dogs were never designed by nature to eat the modern prepared diets designed to appeal to humans through extensive advertising and promotion. Carnivores were designed to eat periodically and the whole carcass of their prey (minus stomach contents) with some soil and grass thrown in. And this needed a lot of physical tearing, chewing and digesting - hence the book title stressing the value of raw meaty bones.

But can you imagine his mission to get the mega-zillion-dollar pet food industry to accept this, and many of his veterinary colleagues who make money from selling prepared pet foods from the big corporates in their clinics. Worse still, the large corporates support research on pet diets. It's revealing (but not surprising) to read the battle he and his "meaty bone" colleagues had with their professional association to get their views published.

The book clearly explains their simple message. Apart from a pet diet being nutritionally adequate, it should have physical qualities like texture, abrasiveness and chewiness. Making the animal's teeth, jaws and digestive system work like nature intended will reduce visits to the vet to fix bad breath, bleeding gums, and bad flatulence. Vets make a lot of money from this trio.

The book contains a wealth of common sense (when pointed

It's a book serious cat and dog enthusiasts should read, and if your veterinarians haven't read it, go to a clinic where they have. It could cut your costs of pet care substantially and this would easily cover the price of the book.
